



# WSD Guest Attestation (Health Screening) Forms

To maintain a safe work environment for all of our employees, volunteers, and vendors, the Wahluké School District, DOH, and L&I requires that all staff screen themselves for COVID symptoms and complete our Daily Health Screening form before, or upon arrival at any of our District facilities. WSD understands that this health screening form is not a permanent solution. Still, it will help our efforts to have every staff, volunteer, or vendor screening themselves before entering the District facilities. The screening form is available on our website ([bit.ly/WSDGuestForm](https://bit.ly/WSDGuestForm)) and as a paper format in each District building.

We have followed guidance from the Grant County Health District (GCHD) to develop the screening questions and protocol.

## SCREENING PROTOCOL

**IF** you need to be on the WSD campus for more than 15 minutes, please follow this screening protocol.

- **\*\* Before your arrival, YOU NEED TO CHECK YOUR TEMPERATURE. If you have a fever of 100.4F, STAY HOME. \*\***
- **\*\*Thermometers are available at the front desk if you don't already have one or did not take your temperature before arrival.\*\***
- **\*\*Complete the Health Screening Form either electronically via our website, or using a paper form.\*\***
- **\*\*If you answer yes to any of the screening questions, DO NOT COME ON SITE, and notify your supervisor. Our district nurse will collect your completed screening forms; however, you must notify your supervisor of any newly detected symptoms that are not caused by another condition, as the nurse will not be reviewing the screening results in real-time.\*\***

In addition to the daily screening, we want to remind everyone of the **on-site safety measures** required by all people in and around our District facilities:

- Face coverings must be worn, whether inside or out, by all people on-site when not working alone.
- Wash your hands frequently with soap and water (if not readily available use hand sanitizer)
- Maintain a distance of 6 feet inside and outside - If less distance is required, it should be for shorts periods (less than 15 minutes), and masks are required.
- Stay home if you are sick to protect yourself and others.
