

2023 Ross County 4-H Scholarships

Return to the Ross County Extension Office before 4:30 p.m. on January 15th, 2023

With the gracious donations and funds from The Ross County 4-H Committee, Kingston National Bank, Ross County CARTEens, and the Nicky Morris Memorial Scholarship, Ross County 4-H awards almost \$10,000 annually for 4-H seniors to attend ANY post-secondary college, university or trade school.

Selection Procedures and Criteria

To be eligible, Applicants must be:

- A current high school senior
- A current Ross County 4-H member in good standing

To apply for our Ross County 4-H Scholarships, submit all of the following to the Ross County Extension Office by 4:30 p.m. January 15, 2023, attach:

- Ross County 4-H Scholarship Application (*typed, hard/paper copy*)
- Current transcript of your grades
- A one-page letter of support from your academic advisor, guidance counselor, teacher, community leader, or employer
