

Dear Senior,

The Chillicothe Jaycees are looking to award two \$500 scholarships to Ross County high school seniors attending college in the fall of 2023.

The criteria for the Jaycees Scholarship are:

1. A certified copy of your high school transcript from a Ross County school.
2. The completed application page.
3. A recommendation from a faculty member.
4. Proof of acceptance into a college or university. (This can be a copy of the acceptance letter you received from the college.)**
5. Copy of ACT/SAT score, if it is not listed on your transcript.
6. Application Questions

If all items are not included, applications will not be considered.

**If college proof of acceptance has not yet been received, scholarship recipient will be responsible for forwarding college acceptance letter to the Chillicothe Jaycees Scholarship Committee Chair as soon as possible. Scholarship reward will be held pending proof of acceptance.

After all applications have been received and reviewed, an interview process may be conducted. In the event that interviews are conducted, they will take place at the Chillicothe Jaycees Golf Course Clubhouse on Thursday, May 4th 2023 from 5-8pm. Interested applicants must be available for interview on this date if selected. There will be no interviews scheduled outside of this date.

Applications must be mailed to: Chillicothe Jaycees, Attn: Scholarship Committee, P.O. Box 6186, Chillicothe, Ohio 45601. No applications will be accepted at the Golf Course Clubhouse. Applications are due to the Jaycees no later than April 21st, 2023 and must be received by this date in order to be considered. Applications cannot be dropped off at the golf course, they must be mailed to the post office box.
