As we prepare to kick off the 2020 Outlaw football season, the following procedures and protocols set forth by the Arkansas Department of Health and the Arkansas Activities Association will be followed by the Dierks School District in order for our student activities to proceed this school year. We appreciate your efforts to comply with the following guidelines below for these activities to continue.

- The 6 foot social distancing and face masks requirement for everyone over the age of 10, in accordance with the Arkansas Department of Health guidelines, must be worn by all in attendance in all areas of Ayers Stadium.
- Both admission gates will open at 5:30.
- Arkansas Activities Association (AAA) and local passes will be accepted unless the stadium reaches the allowable capacity.
- Ticket allotments were determined by allowing each player, band member, and cheerleader six (6) tickets each to be presented at the admission gate with \$5 per ticket. Having the correct change will not only reduce the amount of time standing in line, it will provide a safer environment for those working in the ticket booths by reducing money exchanged. An additional 200 tickets will be available to purchase at the admission gate as well.
- Ticket allotments will also be provided to the players and parents of the opponents.
- Bleacher seating will be available on every other row at six (6) foot increments, with the only allowable exception being for families to sit together. Obviously, the availability of seating in the bleachers will be reduced and will require other spectators to stand in available areas along the track.
- The fence will be marked with ribbon to indicate the required six (6) foot increments expected to be followed while being mindful to keep walk ways clear for traffic to the restrooms and concession stand areas.
- The concession stands will be open but will be limited on the number of items to sale to comply with current guidelines.
- Children must remain with a parent, guardian, or supervising adult at all times.

- No gatherings in spirit lines before the game or at the completion of the games are allowed.
- Efforts are being made to provide a livestream option for Outlaw fans who are unable to attend.
