

Notice of Public Hearing

The Oroville City Elementary School District will hold a public hearing regarding the sufficiency of textbooks and instructional materials in each subject that are consistent with the content and cycles of the curriculum frameworks as adopted by the State Board of Education.

The Oroville City Elementary School District Board of Trustees will be asked to certify that the District has complied with provisions in Education Code §60119 for funds received under the Pupil Textbook and Instructional Materials Incentive Program and/or funds from any State source in grades K-8 for the 2019-2020 fiscal year. Each pupil in the district, grades K-8, has been provided with a standards aligned textbook or basic instructional materials to be able to take home required for homework in each of the following areas:

- Language Arts
- Math
- Science
- Social Studies

In addition, at the middle school level there is a sufficiency of textbooks in health and foreign language which can also be taken home for homework. These instructional materials were purchased from an approved standards-aligned adoption list as required by CCR, Title 5, Section 9531. The local governing board provided each pupil with these standards based materials as required by Education Code Sections 60422(a) and 60422.1.

This certification is required in order to receive funding for the Pupil Textbook and Instructional Materials Incentive Program (Education Code §60252).

The above notice hearing will be held during the regularly scheduled board meeting on Wednesday, September 16, 2020, beginning at 5:00 p.m. at Oroville City Elementary School District Office, located at 2795 Yard Street in Oroville.
