

## Washington State Schools Daily Symptom Checker

The Daily Symptom Checker is designed for staff and families (students and parents) to self-assess their health on a daily basis. The COVID-19 Self-Assessment is delivered to parents/guardians daily via email or text. Parents are responsible for completing one assessment per student.

Those who are symptom-free will receive a time-stamped certification to participate in school and related activities. If the symptoms indicate a potential COVID-19 infection, the solution will display further instructions for self-care. The solution produces a certification delivered by email or text that includes the certificate result. Teachers and supervisors are notified when their students or staff are not eligible to come to school for the day.

In order to effectively use the Symptom Checker, parents and guardians will need to do the following:

- Monitor your child(ren) DAILY for [COVID symptoms](#).
- Complete the COVID-19 Self-Assessment (Daily Self-Assessment) for each child BEFORE coming to school each day.
- Develop a plan to pick up your child(ren) from school promptly if they are presenting with a COVID-like symptom(s) while at school.
