To Cuba High School Seniors and Parents/Guardians,

Last spring your class was scheduled to take the SAT at school on April 14th. The SAT is a state required accountability assessment that all students are required to take in order to graduate from high school. Like many other things, this event was cancelled due to COVID. Because your scheduled SAT date was cancelled, you will have the opportunity to take the assessment at school this fall, on **October 14th**.

Any senior who was scheduled to take the SAT in the Spring 2020 may choose to participate in the October 2020 SAT to meet the diploma requirement and have the opportunity to receive a timely college and scholarship reportable score. Seniors who choose to participate in the October 2020 SAT will not be required or allowed to participate in the SAT in April 2021. Seniors who choose not to participate in the October 2020 SAT will be required to participate in the April 2021 administration of SAT to meet the diploma requirement.

We encourage all seniors to choose to take the SAT on October 14th. Each senior is allowed to participate in only one of the school administered testing dates, but they must participate in one or the other in order to receive their diploma. Our plan at this time is to administer the SAT at school for all seniors. We will follow all required health and social distancing guidelines as well as ISBE and the SAT administration regulations.

We will meet with you soon to discuss the SAT and what needs to be done prior to the October 14th test date. Pay attention to your email and other district communications for more information about the SAT and details on how it will be administered as the date gets closer.
