## CURRICULUM COURSE OUTLINE

Course Name(s): Concert Band

| Grade(s): | $7 \& 8$ |
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| Department: | Music |

Course Length: One year; every day
Pre-requisite: Beginning Band (or transfer student equivalent)

Textbook/Key Resource: Standard of Excellence (Book 2)

Course Description: In concert band, students will continue to learn about music and their instrument by continuing to progress in their book. In addition, new concepts will be added with units on Marching and Solo \& Ensemble performance.

| Unit: Intro to marching | Unit Length: 1 month |
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| Students will know: The basics of music and movement by marching and playing on their instrument. Topics covered include breathing, phrasing, posture, pulse, with a stress on emphasizing articulations. In addition, percussion students will learn about cadences and some students will be introduced to colorguard. | Students will be able to: Perform a piece while marching as one unit. |
| Standard(s): B, E, H, I |  |
| Unit: Patriotic Music | Unit Length: 1.5 months |
| Students will know: How to play two patriotic pieces on their instruments. These pieces will be performed at the annual Veteran's Day ceremony at SCMS. Students will go over a brief history of the pieces (service songs: Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard). | Students will be able to: Perform two pieces: The Star Spangled Banner and the Salute to America's Finest. |
| Standard(s): B, E, I |  |
| Unit: Holiday Concert | Unit Length: 1 month |
| Students will know: More advanced band concepts: 6/8 time, cut time, syncopation, etc. through the pieces they perform for their Winter band concert (Holiday Concert). | Students will be able to: Perform 4-5 pieces using more challenging concepts. |
| Standard(s): B, E |  |


| Unit: Solo \& Ensemble | Unit Length: 2.5 months |
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| Students will know: How to play a solo (class <br> C minimum). Most students will also be <br> introduced to the role of the accompanist and <br> how it relates to their performance. | Students will be able to: Perform a WSMA <br> solo (Class C or better). They will also be able <br> to tell some sort of interesting aspect of the <br> piece (or composer) they are performing. |


| Unit: Spring Concert | Unit Length: 1 month |
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| Students will know: More advanced music <br> techniques by performing literature that is even <br> more challenging than that of the fall (grade 2.5- <br> 3 literature). | Students will be able to: perform 4-5 pieces <br> of increased difficulty music literature. |
