## **Course Description:**

This is an introductory course in which Spanish 1 learners practice listening, speaking, reading and writing in the present tense to communicate effectively using the target language for real-life purposes. The course begins with simple phrases and grammar points needed to communicate in a Spanish-speaking country and gradually transition to more complex grammar points and phrases. Students are exposed to snapshots of culture and are asked to directly compare and contrast those cultures, customs and languages. Students use the target language as a tool to accomplish a specific purpose in a particular setting about a particular subject.
