### **Course Description:**

In this intermediate course, Spanish 2 learners build and elaborate on listening, speaking, reading and writing principles learned in Spanish I. This course focuses on expanding the present and introduces the preterite tense to communicate effectively using the target language for real-life purposes. Students are exposed to snapshots of culture and are asked to directly compare and contrast those cultures, customs and languages. Students use the target language as a tool to accomplish a specific purpose in a particular setting about a particular subject.
