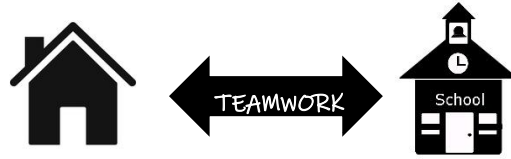

1: JOINTLY DEVELOPED

7: BUILDING CAPACITY OF PARENTS
