One of the requirements for us to return to the schools is the “screening” before we attend each and every day. Those of you who provided your school with an e-mail address will have received an email from MyMedBot or it may have gone to your child’s email if they are of high school age. This email provides you with an “invite code” to sign into the MyMedBot app. This app is designed to make it easier to determine if it is safe to come to school and your school nurse is then alerted if there is a reason not to. This tool can be used, not only on Smart phones, but on laptops, iPads, Chromebooks and tablets.

If you did not get the email from MyMedBot with the “invite code” you would need to contact your school to provide your email address to update your Apptegy settings. Useful information:
