Sandy Creek Covid Procedures for Athletic Events

Sandy Creek High School Gym

Using the current DHM mandates and NSAA guidelines where available, which we anticipate being in place for the foreseeable future. Hand sanitizing stations will be provided and masks are recommended. <u>ALL</u>

PROTOCOLS ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE!

Entrance and Exit Strategies

- Home Fans will enter through the Activity Entrance.
- Visiting Fans will park south of the gym, west of the high school and enter in the south gym doors.
- All fans must have a ticket to the event issued by the Sandy Creek Athletic Department.
 Tickets will be sent to opposing teams and distributed to Sandy Creek Athletes well before the date of the event. Each athlete will be given 6 tickets. <u>Tickets do not take the place of paid admission!</u> Conference passes accepted as always.

Gym Capacity/Occupancy

- 50% Capacity per the NSAA Return to Activities Guidelines, Phase III, so we have a limit of 500 in our gym at one time.
- Maintain 6' distancing between family groups.
- Sandy Creek fans will sit on the north side of the gym and on the stage, visiting fans will sit on the south side of the gym.
- All fans will exit through the entrance they came in.

Concessions

- Concession stand will be in the middle of the commons with a side for Sandy Creek fans and a side for visiting fans
- All concessions workers will wear gloves and masks
- Concessions workers will have assigned duties (ie popcorn, money handler)
- No community condiments. Workers will dispense the condiments.
- Concession stands will be limited to bottled drinks, popcorn, candy, and hotdogs. No special deals or menu.
- No concessions at non varsity contests.

Students

- No Pep Band will play.
- Students must sign up ahead of time in the office to attend the game.
- Student section will be modified to follow social distancing.

No spectators will be allowed on the floor before or after games. Athletes will not be permitted to come out of the locker room and talk with parents after the game.

Clay Center Gym

Entrance and Exit Strategies

 Fans will enter in the north activity doors and exit out the east gym doors on their side of the gym.

Gym Capacity/Occupancy

- 50% Capacity per the NSAA Return to Activities Guidelines, Phase III, so we have a limit of 400 in our gym at one time.
- Maintain 6' distancing between family groups.
- Sandy Creek fans will sit on the north side of the gym, and visiting fans will sit on the south side of the gym.
- All fans must have a ticket to the event issued by the Sandy Creek Athletic Department.
 Tickets will be sent to opposing teams and distributed to Sandy Creek Athletes well before the date of the event. Each athlete will be given 6 tickets. <u>Tickets do not take the place of paid admission!</u> Conference passes accepted as always.

Concessions

No Concessions will be provided at the Clay Center Site.

Students

- No Pep Band will play.
- Students must sign up ahead of time in the office to attend the game.
- Student section will be modified to follow social distancing.

No spectators will be allowed on the floor before or after games. Athletes will not be permitted to come out of the locker room and talk with parents after the game.

Volleyball Game Procedures

- Reserve and Freshman Games will not switch benches or sides of the court.
- Reserve Games will have a 45 minute time limit or win in 2 sets.
- Road teams will bring their own volleyballs for warm-up.
- Varsity Bench Personnel will follow the team on the floor around the net when switching benches at sets.
- Benches will be disinfected and wiped down by a student manager.
- 3 Game Balls will be used per match so they can be disinfected at timeouts and between sets.
- Increased space will be provided on team benches for social distancing requirements.
- No post-game handshakes between teams will be allowed.
- No sharing of towels or water bottles.
- Athletes must leave the floor immediately following the contest and will not be allowed to talk with family or friends after the contest.
