At this time, your child should have a chromebook so that he/she can begin virtual learning on the first day of school, September 8, 2020. If your child does not have a chromebook, please send an email to chromebook@wboe.net.

On September 8, 2020, your child should follow the Option 2 (all-virtual instructional model) schedule that is aligned to his/her grade level (see Appendix G-J in the Reopening Plan). Your child's school day will begin with a homeroom period from 8:15 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. During this time, attendance will be recorded. The instructional day is scheduled from 8:30 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.

You will have access to your child's class schedule via Genesis by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, September 4, 2020.

Parents/Guardians or students can pick up 1 to 2 days of breakfast and lunch meals at Levitt Intermediate School or Memorial Middle School according to the following:

Both cold and hot meals will be served. Parents are encouraged to complete a lunch application in Genesis before the first day of meal distribution (September 8, 2020). All students will receive free meals.
