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Dwight Public Schools Daily Self-Certification Guidelines for Bus Riders

September 3, 2020

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Illinois State Board of Education has mandated that all students have daily temperature checks and COVID-19 symptom screenings prior to entering the school building and/or bus each day. Bus riders will need to self-certify that they are free of symptoms by filling out the Self-Certification Card daily. Car riders and/or walkers will be symptoms checked at the door by faculty.

We are asking that parents complete the symptom screening each morning at home.

Please Note: During the symptom screening, we are asking about NEW and/or UNEXPLAINED symptoms.

Daily Symptom Screening Process Beginning Tuesday, September 8th

- There are 30 self-certification cards enclosed with this letter. You will fill out one card each day your child attends in-person learning.

- 1. Fill out the card in the morning before your child leaves the house. You should put the date at the top, mark Yes or No for **ALL** symptoms, and sign at the bottom.
 - **Note:** If you mark YES for any symptoms, your child should be kept home.

- 2. Students will hand the card to the bus driver or monitor each morning.

- 3. If your child does not have the self-certification card, the symptom screening will be completed by the bus driver and/or monitor. However, if the child repeatedly forgets his/her card, bus privileges may be suspended.

While we understand this process may pose an inconvenience, please know this is a strict mandate from our State Board of Education. We have worked to find a process that will not place too much of a burden on our families while still fulfilling the requirement.
