

Exeter-Milligan Public School  
Regular School Board Meeting  
February 12, 2014 - Milligan, Nebraska

President S. Kuska called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm. Those present were: A. Gloystein, B. Moore, J. Zeleny, T. Pribyl, S. Kuska, T. Sluka, Superintendent Sheffield, and Principal Kroll. Visitors were: J. Marr, B. Murphy, M. Nicholas and Michelle Rayburn from ESU 6. The Nebraska Open Meetings Act was posted.

Motion by A. Gloystein and seconded by B. Moore to verify that this meeting of the school board of the Exeter-Milligan Public School was duly advertised and that all board members were notified as to the time and place of the meeting pursuant to board policy and practice. Motion carried 6-0.

Motion by T. Pribyl and seconded by B. Moore to approve the consensus agenda consisting of the Treasurer's Report, minutes of the January 15, 2014 regular board meeting and the January 22, 2014 work session, and the February expenditures.

#### Curriculum Report

Michelle Rayburn from ESU 6 gave the board information about the preschool program that ESU 6 will be in charge of this fall located at the Exeter site. She answered questions and gave the board an overview of what would be happening pertaining to age requirements, teachers and paraprofessionals, length of sessions and length of school year.

#### Old Business

The building committee met with Clark-Enersen on February 5, 2014. Since then the company has sent representatives to both sites and will meet with the building committee again later in February.

Motion by A. Gloystein and seconded by B. Moore to accept Bob Mahoney's resignation and to wish him good luck on his retirement. Motion carried 6-0.
