Study all previous facts!

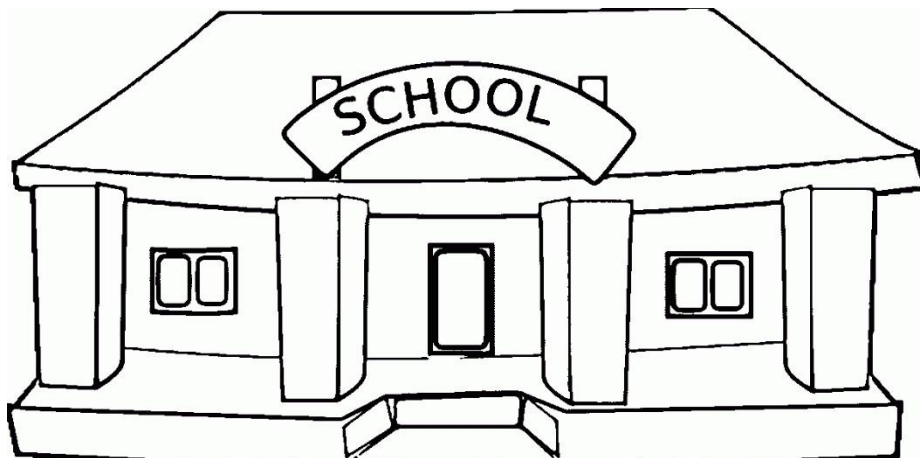

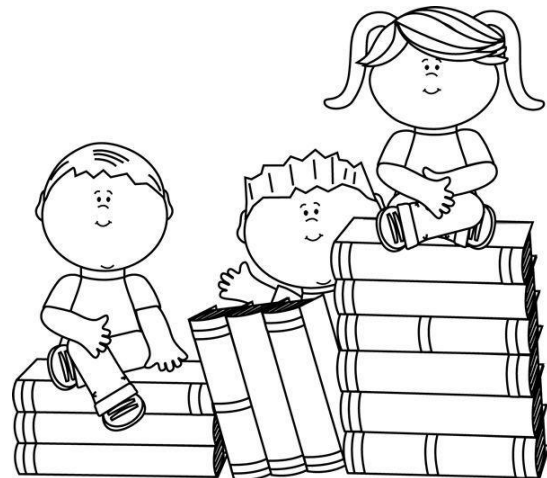
