

Families in Transition Program

Nixon Smiley provides assistance to families meeting criteria for the McKinney-Vento Education Act implemented to ensure all students the right to an education regardless of their living situation.

Families in transition may include:

- Living with someone else temporarily
- Living in a motel or shelter
- Living in a RV
- Families with no home to live in (ex. living in a car)
- Youth that are living in a place without their parent or legal guardian

The program provides the necessary supports to increase the likelihood that students living in transition, homelessness, or chronic poverty attend school consistently and with little interruption. These services include immediate enrollment, nutrition via the free/reduced lunch program and transportation.
