Chilton ISD Athletic Event Procedures

Pirate Nation:

Our student-athletes, coaches, and fans are excited about the 2020-2021 competition season. We appreciate your continued support and dedication to Chilton ISD Athletics. With the current status of Covid-19 and all the new UIL/TEA protocols and guidelines, we will need to adjust how our spectators/fans support our Pirate student-athletes.

- All home competition games will be streamed live through the Chilton ISD Facebook Page.
- All home game tickets will be pre-sold electronically through our partnership with HomeTown Ticketing. Procedures for away games will be shared weekly via the Chilton ISD website, Chilton ISD Facebook Page, and the Chilton ISD Mobile App.
- All tickets will be general admission and sold on a first come; first served basis.
- Schools will remain on their designated side of the gymnasium or stadium unless using a restroom facility. Social distancing protocol will be maintained.
- The purchase of tickets will be set at one price. Football: Varsity/JV/JH \$5; Gym Sports: Varsity/JV/JH \$5. **NO TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE GATE! ALL TICKETS MUST BE PRE-PURCHASED using the HomeTown Tickets website. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A TICKET YOU CAN NOT ENTER THE FACILITY. (NO ENTRY AND RE-ENTRY WILL BE ENFORCED)**
- Employees of the district are allowed 1 ticket per home event based upon availability.
- Arrive early to go through a quick health and temperature screen to determine if you meet entry requirements.
- All spectators/fans must wear a mask in the bleachers and adhere to social distancing principles set by the local administration in conjunction with local, state, and federal guidelines.

Exceptions:

- 1. A person with a medical condition or disability that prevents wearing a face covering.**
- 2. A person consuming food or drink.**

- Persons unwilling to adhere to district safety protocols will be asked to leave the event and facility.
- Spectators/fans allowed by UIL guidelines can fluctuate. Chilton ISD will change our ticket sales to accommodate that number. Football Stadium: (Home Side 422, Visitor Side 222) Gym Sports: (HS; Home Side 161, Visitor Side 70) **Participants include band, drill team, cheer, crew, trainers, volleyball teams, basketball teams, and football teams.**
- Band and drill teams of each school will be in chairs on the track north and south ends of the football stadium. **Visiting groups will need to provide their own chairs to accommodate their groups.**
