

## How to use the Kajeet Hot Spot

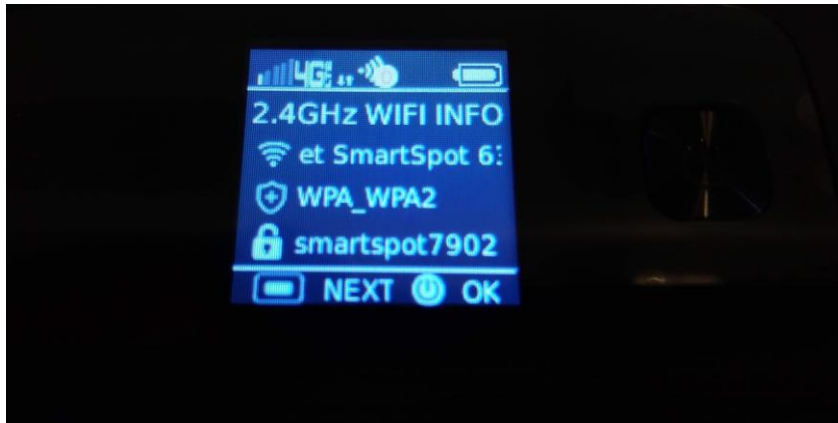
To use the hot spot, you must make sure it has a charge. Plug the power adapter into a wall outlet and then plug the cable into the hot spot. If the battery is completely dead, it could take up to 10-15 min before it has enough charge to turn on. To turn on the device, press and hold the power button on the front of the unit for about 4 seconds.



Next you need to find the password to connect to the hot spot. Press the menu button located on the top edge of the device until you see the screen in the picture below:

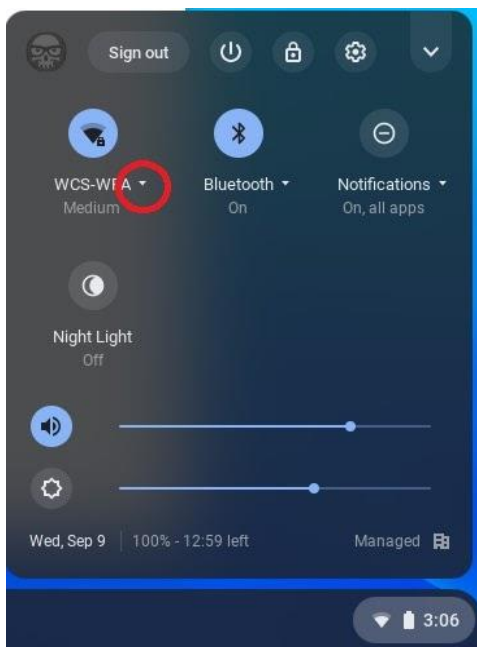


Then press the power on the front to select that menu option (don't hold down the power button, just do a quick press). After that you should see a screen similar to the one below. The information to the right of the lock icon is your password. You will need to use this when connecting with a device. (The picture below is for reference only. The password for each device is unique.)



### How to connect your Chromebook to the hot spot:

First Turn on your Chromebook, then click on the time in the lower right corner. Next click on the arrow below the Wifi icon (circled in red below).



You should then see a list of available WiFi networks. Click on the one that has Kajeet at the beginning.



Next you will be prompted to enter the password for this Wifi Network. Enter the Password you found earlier in the hot spot's device information menu. Then click on Connect.

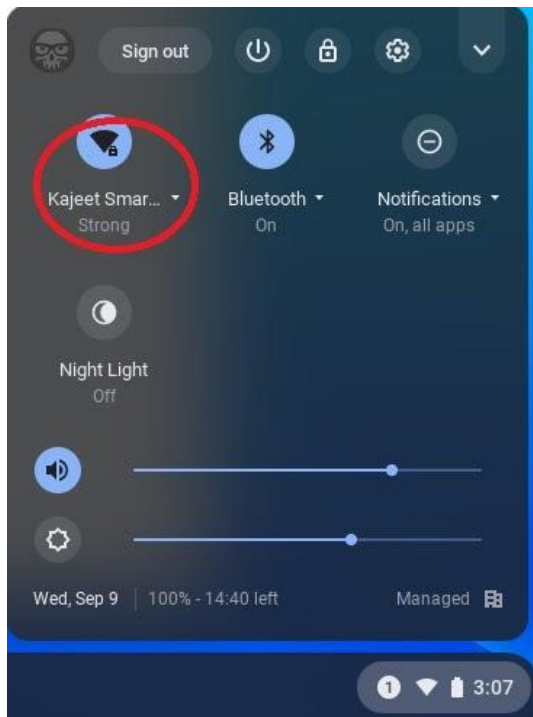

If you entered the correct password, it will connect to the hot spot. You can check to make sure you are connected by clicking on the time in the lower right corner. You should see the name Kajeet below the Wifi Icon.



Please note that you cannot connect multiple devices to a hot spot at the same time. Only one device at a time can be connected to the hot spot.
