## Spectator Attendance at Athletic Events - Home Games

## 9/10/2020

As of this date our athletic events are limited to 250 people total at our outdoor events and a total of 25 for indoor events. These numbers are inclusive of the student participants, officials, and event staff. While we are very fortunate to be able to have the events for our students, the limitations currently in place will cause restrictions for how many people may be present to watch the events as spectators.

We are additionally charged with making sure the event is safe and healthy for everyone involved. Those that will be able to attend will need to comply with all expected safety guidelines so that we are not forced to forfeit events and impact our students in a negative fashion. This will also require that only ticket holders will be able to be present at the events and on school grounds.

While we know this is not what anyone likes, it was only a month ago we were hoping the students would have the opportunity to at least play. They have that, so please help us keep the opportunity we have for our students.

Below are our current expected processes as we move forward:

<u>Volleyball:</u> At this point in time we are not able to have any spectators at the volleyball matches. We will be making efforts to stream the events as much as we are able.

<u>Boys and Girls Soccer:</u> With current roster size of each soccer team and the required people to work the event, we will be able to provide each soccer player with four (4) passes for use at their level of play and for their sport only. As an example, a JH Girls soccer player will receive four passes that will be good only for JH Girls soccer.

**Golf, Cross Country and Tennis:** We will be issuing four (4) passes to each player for these events.

<u>Junior High Football and Cheerleading:</u> Two (2) passes will be issued to each player and cheerleader. We do ask that you wait to arrive until the time of your child's game and that you leave at the conclusion of your child's game. Normally a Junior High football game night will consist of two games, please attend the only the one your child may be playing in or be involved with so that we can accommodate as many parents as possible.

Junior Varsity Football and Cheerleading: Two (2) passes will be issued to each player and cheerleader.

<u>Varsity Football (Friday Nights):</u> Two (2) passes will be issued to senior players and senior cheerleaders only. Band will be participating at the home events. Separate band shows will be scheduled throughout the fall that will allow each band student two (2) passes to attend the separate band show(s). We will be making efforts to stream the events as much as we are able.

## **Pass Rules**

Each pass is provided to the student for the season, lost passes do not get replaced

- 1. Spectator choosing to use this pass understands the risk associated with COVID 19 and assumes all responsibility and liability if they were to contract the virus.
- 2. Spectator confirms that they are in good health today and that they have had no signs or symptoms that would indicate they are sick.
- 3. Spectator will wear their facemask whenever they are present and near others, or as required by the school.
- 4. Spectator will follow all school guidelines in regards to social distancing and proper behavior at a school sporting event.
- 5. Any violation of the above, or any of the school's existing rules pertaining to fans at school events, such as use of tobacco products, drugs and/or alcohol will at the minimum cause forfeiture of the spectator pass for the season.
