LAPTOP GUIDELINES

The laptop, adapter, protective cover, and carrying case that are issued to you are the property of Maranacook Area Schools. Use of the laptop is a privilege, not a right. Students are expected to follow the guidelines and treat the equipment with respect. The laptop is a tool to enhance and support teaching and learning it is NOT intended to be a personal entertainment device.

- Annually, each student and a family member will sign the acceptable use policy (AUP) and return it with the \$40 Use Fee. The laptop will be issued to the student following the receipt of the signed AUP form and the fee.
- Each laptop will be assigned and registered to an individual student. Do not swap or lend your laptop to another person.
- Never take your laptop out of the protective cover. Always put it in the carrying case when transporting it.
- Laptops are subject to random inspection and may be confiscated. The school's Student Computer and Internet Use Policy must be followed at all times. This may be found on our website. <https://mcms.maranacook.org/o/mcms/browse/58492>
- Do not mark or place stickers on the laptop.
- Do not take pictures/videos of friends. This violates the media release documents we have at school. A maximum of 200 school related photos are allowed since this takes a lot of space on your device and will slow it down.
- Laptops should return to school **fully charged every day**. If you forget your laptop at home, you will not have another computer to use. If a student repeatedly forgets their laptop at home, the student's right to take the laptop home may be taken away.
- Laptops are not allowed out of the carrying case while riding the bus to or from school. If the laptop is used on the bus and damage occurs, the full amount of the repair will be the student's responsibility.
- If students are traveling by bus to an away game or activity, laptops will be left at school in a designated area for the night and charged. For after school practices, laptops will be stored in a designated space.
- Misuse or neglectful care will result in disciplinary action which could include taking away the laptop for a period of time. If you are seen mistreating your laptop it will be taken away **BEFORE** it breaks. You will get it back when we feel assured that you know how to treat it.
