



IF SOMEONE IN YOUR FAMILY HAS LICE.....

1. **Inform the school nurse.** Information will be kept confidential, however screening procedures will be done upon notification.
2. Get a lice treatment shampoo at an area store, **read/follow all instructions** on the label, as different products require different steps.
3. Wash all bed linens, towels, clothing, hairbrushes, combs, scarves, hats, etc. (anything that has had contact with the infected person's hair) in **HOT** water and follow with a **HOT** rinse.
4. Anything unable to be washed (i.e. stuffed toys, bean bag chairs, **backpacks**, etc.), seal in a plastic garbage bag for 1-2 weeks.
5. Vacuum all rugs, upholstered furniture, **and car seats.**
6. Comb nits out of hair (can be a tedious process but needs to be done).
7. Call your physician if you have further questions/concerns regarding treating other family members, prevention products, resistance, reoccurrence, or any other information.
8. Students may return to school after the lice treatment/shampoo has been completed.
