RE: Fall 2020 Attendance Protocol

We would first like to thank you all for your patience as we have navigated the ever changing landscape this fall regarding athletics/activities. We are pleased that we can provide these opportunities to our students and strive to do all we can to continue to provide them.

With that in mind, we are informing you of the attendance protocol for the Fall Sports Season. This protocol was created in consultation with WIAA recommendations, Buffalo County Health Department, and the schools of the Dunn-St. Croix/Cloverbelt Conference. We fully understand that this may not be the most ideal situation for all families, but this is what schools feel needs to be done to ensure students continue to get the opportunity to partake in interscholastic athletics/activities.

The following guidelines will be in place:

1. Each athlete and coach will be provided four wristbands that they can decide who gets one for each game. The wristband will be your admittance to the game and only those with a wristband will be allowed in at each game.
2. Those in attendance should wear facial coverings as stated in any state, county, or district mandate, based on if the event is indoors or outdoors.
3. We ask that all families sit together with those in their household and physically distance from those in other households.
4. Each participating team will have their own seating section and we ask that you sit in those defined areas.
5. We are asking that all fans arrive as close as possible to the event start time of the athlete who provided them their wristband.
6. Upon completion of your event, we ask that all fans leave the location of the competition, not to congregate, and allow space for those that are watching the next event to enter the facility.
7. By agreeing to the use of the wristband, the user is agreeing to abide by all state, county, and host district protocols or mandates related to facial coverings and physical distancing. If you are unable to abide by the protocols we ask for you to not attend the event and instead watch the event via live-stream.

Please understand that all districts are handling their event attendance protocols and procedures differently. We ask that you please respect the procedures of other districts based on their discussions with the county and local decision making authority. We will communicate with you prior to each event with the protocols of those we compete against.

For those unable to attend the events, we will be live-streaming all home events from Middle School to Varsity. Most other schools will also be live-streaming their events as well. We will get you the links to those live-streams as we receive them and put them on the school facebook page.

We are posting this information sheet out to all parents/guardians/spectators of our athletes, but will be sending the wristbands home with each athlete. It is the responsibility of each family to decide who gets the wristbands on a game-by-game basis. The district will not be involved in deciding who gets to come to games, we will only ensure that those that attend the game have the wristband needed to attend.
