School Attendance is IMPORTANT! Being in school all day, every day, helps your child get the most out of their education. Picking your child up even just 5 minutes early or dropping them off late everyday causes them to lose out on 14 days of school!

*There is NO substitute for being in class. Students need to be present to hear teachers explain concepts, to participate in group projects and class discussions, and to ask questions.

*Schedule doctor, dentist, and orthodontist appointments for before or after school hours whenever possible. If you can't, try to arrange them around lunch time.

*It will be easier for your child to get up on time for school if he/she has had a good night's sleep. Set a reasonable bedtime, and make sure electronic devices are put away so he/she isn't tempted to stay awake to play games or correspond with friends.
