### a. RESOLUTION 20-21-03 GANN APPROPRIATION LIMIT

Voters approved Proposition 4 in November of 1979, an initiative that added Article XIII B to the California Constitution. This constitutional amendment, also known as the Gann initiative, placed limits on the growth of expenditures for publicly funded programs. Division 9 of Title 1, beginning with Section 7900 of the Government Code, was then added to law to establish the process for calculating state and local government appropriations limits and appropriations subject to limitation under Article XIII B of the California Constitution. These constitutional and statutory sections explain and define the appropriations limit and appropriations subject to limitation as they apply to state and local government. It is recommended the Board of Trustees adopt the Gann Appropriation limits for fiscal year 2020-2021.
