CONNEAUT SCHOOL LUNCH PROGRAM 2020-2021

Dear Parent:

Welcome back to the 20/21 school year. This year like no other will be challenging in all aspects of learning. This includes the food service department. While we still will be serving your child for days they are on site, we are authorized to offer breakfasts and lunches for off site student days also. For planning purposes, we need a commitment from you that you will pick up meals at the school you designate for **the entire semester**. The USDA announced on August 31, 2020 that all meals provided either on site or off site will be at the free rate for students of Conneaut School District thru December 31, 2020.

Students attending SOAR, Gold "2" and Gold "4" hybrid models, need to complete the commitment form at the bottom of this sheet to receive breakfast/lunch meals on Mondays at the requested location. Please fill out completely and send back as soon as possible.

Even if you are unsure if your family may qualify for free or reduced meals through the NSLP, or if you are not planning to utilize the meal service, it is important for potentially eligible families to complete and submit one application per household. Many federal and state grants and other programs are allocated to the district using this information to determine funding, providing more options for our district to educate your children.

For planning purposes, we are asking for a commitment to provide your child with breakfast and lunch for offsite days. SOAR students will be provided with five (5) days of breakfasts and lunches. Gold "2" grades 3-12 will be provided with three (3) days of breakfasts and lunches. Gold "4" grades K-2 will be provided with one (1) day of breakfast and lunch. The meals are provided for student days only, meaning that when there is a school break, the number of off site meals will be adjusted to match student days. Just a reminder, all meals provided either on site or off site at the <u>free rate</u> through the USDA program.

If you sign a commitment for off site meals, we ask that you come to your designated school between the hours 11:00 to 12:00. A cafeteria staff member will be in the office area between 11:00 and 12:00 to distribute meals.
