School is Back in Session with FREE Meals for All In School and Remote Learning Students!

Free Meals include both Breakfast and Lunch! (available through December 31st or until USDA funds are depleted)

The United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) announced that schools may extend the free meals program that Smithfield Schools participated in from March until June. This announcement means that all students age 18 and under will receive **FREE** meals, regardless of eligibility status, beginning Monday, September 14. This includes meals for remote learning students, who will pick up at Smithfield High School, and for those students who are eating in school. Per the USDA, this program will be available through December 31, 2020, or until allocated federal funding is depleted, whichever is sooner. We will notify families if we learn that the program will end before December 31, 2020.

Due to the limited time we anticipate funding may be available, it is important that families continue to submit free/reduced meal applications for the 2020-2021 school year. Confidential applications are accepted throughout the school year and, if benefits are approved, are effective through the last day of the 2020-2021 school year and a few days into the next school year. Applications and instructions for applying can be found by visiting www.Smithfield-ps.org. We are also excited to announce a new online service for entering meal applications. This service will be available starting on September 29, 2020, at which time a link will be available on our website.

Please note we are only able to provide free meals to children 18 and under. Meals will only be provided as a complete meal per program guidelines. All extra items, including milk to accompany a lunch brought from home or ala carte, are not included in this program. We encourage families to put money in their student's account in order to purchase extra items. For safety reasons we discourage the use of cash.

In-school meal service may vary by school.

Weekend meals will be distributed on Friday

Students who will be in a hybrid model may pick up a meal as they leave school if they will be at home the next day.
