

## SRTC FAQs for Students and Parents-2020-2021 School Year

Question	Response
<b>Curriculum, Instruction, Assessment</b>	
<i>Revised 9/4/20</i> When does school begin for SRTC?	School begins on Monday, September 14th for SRTC.
What is the schedule for SRTC this year?	Students will attend for one two-hour session four days per week (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday). Wednesday will be a remote day and students will be expected to check in with their class during their regularly scheduled class time. Attendance will be taken for all five days.
If we have to switch to remote learning this year, what will that look like?	We will spend some time this fall looking at this, but you can expect greater structure and maintaining existing practices for taking attendance and grading. Classes will be expected to meet daily during their regularly scheduled SRTC time.
Will my student be able to complete an internship this year?	As of 9/13/20, this is being reviewed. Because we can't control the precautions put in place in another organization, we need to review our procedures to be certain that internships can be provided in a safe manner for students.
<b>Health and Safety</b>	
Are masks expected in all programs?	Yes, students and staff are expected to wear masks at all times in the building. Even if distancing exceeds 6 feet, masks should be worn. If a mask break is taken, this will occur outside and distancing will exceed 6 feet.
Why does SHS have arrows on the floor in the hallways and do I need to only walk in that direction?	These arrows are meant for use during passing time between SHS classes only. Therefore, the arrows do not apply to SRTC dismissal or students going to the bathroom during class time.
Can students eat in the classroom?	No, students should not eat inside. Program instructors are encouraged to take a break outside during the session with their students. Students may then remove their masks and eat and/or drink, provided they are distanced by 6 feet or more. Alternatives will be arranged for days with inclement weather.
Will visitors be allowed at SRTC?	Visitors will be reviewed carefully prior to any visit taking place. For guest speakers, for example, we will consider if the discussion can occur remotely. If a visit is necessary, guests will be expected to

comply with all precautions and to complete a health screening in advance. Virtual meetings will also be considered for parents and guardians.

### Facilities

How is distancing being achieved in SRTC programs?

Most SRTC programs have a low number of students enrolled. No program has more than 18 students per session and most have fewer than that. Instructional spaces have been arranged to allow for 3-6 feet of distancing between students. Sometimes this involved moving the “classroom” into the shop area. Arrivals and dismissals from SRTC will also be structured to allow and encourage distancing.

### Expectations

Are students allowed to drive this year?

Yes, we have opened up driving in order to take some pressure from transportation departments at all of the schools. Students were provided with the driving form and parents have been submitting these. We will issue parking passes during the first week of school. Students should park in student parking.

Are students allowed to transport a friend or ride as a passenger to SRTC?

Student driving privileges only extend to the student driving his/her self to SRTC. Passengers are not allowed. Students may be driven to SRTC, but only by a parent or guardian.
