Please read through these expectations for athletes, coaches, and fans at home middle school / high school events in Elmwood and Plum City. Please discuss them with your teams and fans before they attend an event. Most of our events will be available through streaming services to try and reduce the numbers of in person spectators. Should fans and teams not follow these expectations and guidelines, we will be forced to postpone the start or continuation of the game until the issue is resolved, or worse, cancel the event and not allow fans at future events. If you are experiencing any symptoms, have been instructed to quarantine, or have a pending Covid-19 test, please stay home. Thank you for your cooperation.

Football

1. Masks and social distancing are expected at all home events.
2. We ask that teams come mostly dressed and ready for competition as the use of locker rooms will be allowed to store valuables.
3. It is expected that coaches and players wear masks at all times. EPC football players will wear masks while competing as well.
4. This year, the visiting teams should park and unload in the lot on the north end of the field near the HS in Plum City. In Elmwood, they should park on the south end of the football field near the baseball field.
 - a. If you are using locker rooms prior to the game, in Plum City you will unload in the same location, and enter through the loading dock door in the back of the school. In Elmwood, you will unload on Woodman St. behind the high school and enter door F.
5. Each EPC athlete will be given two (2) adult only passes to be presented for admission to the events. Visiting teams will also be allowed two (2) adult only fans per athlete. Visiting teams will contact AD Kevin Haglund with the designation, (wrist bands, passes, tickets) that they are using so that our gate workers can identify them for admission. No pass, no admission. No student fans will be admitted from either school.
6. Home and visiting fans will sit on their designated sidelines in socially distant groups.
7. Press box - each team will be allowed a maximum of 2 coaches and one filmer in the press box.
8. At the end of the games teams should wait and allow each team to exit one at a time after teams have their postgame meet with their players.
9. There will be no concessions available during competitions.

Volleyball

1. Masks and social distancing are required at all home events.
2. We ask that teams come mostly dressed and ready for competition as the use of locker rooms will be limited to storing valuables and bags along with restroom facilities.
3. It is required that all coaches and players wear masks at all times.
4. Each EPC athlete will be given two (2) adult passes to be presented for admission to the events. Visiting teams will also be allowed two (2) adult only fans per athlete. Visiting teams will contact AD Kevin Haglund

with the designation, (wrist bands, passes, tickets) that they are using so that our gate workers can identify them for admission. No pass, no admission. No student fans will be admitted.

5. No students from either school will be in attendance at EPC home events.
6. Home and visiting fans will sit in designated areas in socially distant groups. Home fans will sit on the bench side of the gym while visiting fans will sit on the opposite side.
7. Fans should arrive near game time of their athlete's level of competition. At the completion of the competition we ask that those fans then exit the school. We will be clearing the gym between the JV and Varsity matches and we ask those watching the C-team game not walk into the JV or Varsity game. Varsity athletes will not take the floor for warm ups until the JV crowd has exited the gym.
8. Varsity spectators will be asked to wait until the JV game is completed before being allowed in the gym. This process, while inconvenient, will allow for smaller crowds and better social distancing.
9. At the end of the games teams should wait and allow each team to exit one at a time after teams have their postgame meet with their players.
10. There will be no concessions available during competitions.
11. Adults with a pass should park in the southwest parking lot on the corner of May Avenue and Woodman St. South and enter through door N in Elmwood. In Plum City, JV and Varsity adults with a pass should park in the main lot of the High School and enter the front door; for C-team they should park in the lot across the street from the elementary school and enter the front door.
