Guidelines for Athletic Facilities In an effort to meet current recommendations for safety during the current health climate, the following guidelines are in place. There may come a time when there will not be any spectators allowed at athletic events.

FOOTBALL

- There will be no restrictions on attendance at the football games, but there will be reduced bleacher seating.
- Fans are encouraged to bring lawn chairs and social distance.
- Fans may sit at the southeast end zone area and the end zone area by the scoreboard.
- The area in front of the concession stand will not be used for seating.
- Masks required for entry and MUST be worn if six feet of social distancing is not possible.
- Masks must be worn in high traffic areas such as ticketbooth, concession stand and restrooms.
- There will be no entry on the E-Z Mart side of the field.
- For football games, the visiting team's bus can enter from the southwest gate.
- All gate and concession workers will be required to wear masks and gloves.

SOFTBALL

- There will be no restrictions on attendance at the softball games, but there will be reduced bleacher seating.
- Fans are encouraged to bring lawn chairs and social distance.
- Fans may sit along the first and third base fence line.
- Masks required for entry and MUST be worn if six feet of social distancing is not possible.
- Masks must be worn in high traffic areas such as ticketbooth, concession stand and restrooms. THERE WILL BE SIGNS POSTED AS TO WHAT CONSTITUTES MASK AREAS.
