## **Student Expectations**

- Follow district safety protocols such as hand washing, wearing face coverings, and social distancing
- Bring your technology device fully charged to school every day

- Participate in and asynchronous learning activities when the student is remote learning
- Complete and submit work through your Learning Management System on remote learning days
- Take care of your technology device and follow the Acceptable Use Agreement.
- Communicate with teachers through the Learning Management Systems

## **Parents and Families**

- Update your phone numbers and addresses when changes occur. It is very important the school can get a hold of you at all times.
- Have a designated learning space in your home for remote learning.
- Keep your students on a routine while your student is remote learning
- Contact the teacher through the Learning Management System or email if you have questions
- Communicate with the school immediately if your student has tested positive for COVID-19 or has had a close exposure to someone that is COVID-19 positive.
- Communicate to the school when your child needs to be absent from school.
- Re-enroll student(s) in Back to School Registration Gateway
- Have a backup plan for your students in case school is closed due to COVID-19.
- Keep children home if they exhibit COVID-19 symptoms such as a fever over 100.4, cough, rash, diarrhea, or vomiting.
- Communicate to the school when your child needs to be absent from school.
- Talk to your child about the importance of following district safety protocols.
- Communicate with the school your student engagement plan. Notify the school when changes need to be made to the student engagement plan.
