Dear Lima Central Catholic Alumni, Parents and Friends:

When Lima Central Catholic hosts our annual 8th Grade Visit Day for potential students to learn about LCC, it has become tradition for us to perform a skit entitled The Legend of the T-Bird to show how the Thunderbird was selected as our mascot. Legend has it that our fearless leader, the infamous Father Herr, encountered an elder of a Native American tribe on his journey west to seek a suitable mascot for the newly founded Lima Central Catholic. After several moments of silence, a great flash of lightning appeared in the sky and a huge bird-shaped creature flew towards them. After praying the rosary for days, and asking for Mary's assistance, Father Herr knew the mighty thunderbird would be a mascot unlike any other, and perfect for our new school.

There is a lot of rich mythology surrounding the thunderbird. Native American tribes have been passing on their own legends about thunderbirds for years. They tell the stories of birds hundreds of yards long that would soar through the sky bringing rains. When the mighty thunderbird flapped its wings, thunder roared, and when it blinked its eyes, lightning flashed. The Passamaguoddy believe that in the middle of a horrible drought, a member of their village went on a quest, found the thunder and became a thunderbird. But after he got his new power, he didn't forget his old village; he returned to them to guarantee that they would always have rain.





SEGGERSON EVENT A SUCCESS




Former Coach Bob Seggerson was honored at the LCCEF Annual Dinner last October along with members of our first State Championship basketball team, many of whom were in attendance to celebrate the 10th anniversary of this achievement. Coach Seggerson fondly reminisced about his career at LCC as a student, teacher, coach and guidance counselor. "I was immersed in the culture here

that was just perfect for me. My entire family (I come from a big family) are graduates of Lima Central Catholic. To me it's just kind of a pride that I have, having been a student at such a great school," says Seggerson, "to have the opportunity play a role in the lives of so many kids over four decades... the friendships I made and the lives that I touched... I wouldn't trade it for the world."

After Seggerson's keynote speech, Lima Central Catholic Alum Barb O'Connor presented the goals of the LCCEF Capital Campaign and the need to help the school through a projected dip in enrollment. Barb's son, Tyler O'Connor '12, spoke on behalf of the 2010 State Champions and presented a \$5,000 check from the team to the Capital Campaign in honor of Coach Seggerson. This was the third annual fundraising event hosted by the LCC Educational Foundation honoring a distinguished alumni.

Wrestling

Brothers Chase and Gavin Caprella each had outstanding 2019-2020 seasons. Gavin, a sophomore at 106 lbs., qualified for the Division III state tournament with a record of 35-2. Chase, a senior at 132 lbs., was the district runner-up and qualified for the state tournament for the fourth time, finishing with a career record of 132-22. Chase will attend the U.S. Naval Academy this fall. Due to COVID-19, the state tournament was initially postponed in March, then ultimately cancelled.



Cross Country

Senior standout Quentin Potempa qualified for the Boys Division III State Cross Country Championships and finished 92nd out of 181 competitors.



Football

The Thunderbirds' football program qualified for the state playoffs for the 12th time in the last 15 years. They were the #1 seed in their region before falling to Fairview in the opening round of the Division VI playoffs and finished with a 9-2 record.

hen we think about the nature of the Roman Catholic Church, we often think of the Pope in Rome or our local parish where we attend Sunday Mass. At its most basic, this hierarchical structure of the Church can be categorized into four levels: The Universal Church, which is led by the pope in union with all Catholic bishops around the world; the Diocesan Church, headed by the local bishop; the Parish Church, most often ministered to by an ordained priest acting as pastor; and the Domestic Church. The first three levels should be of no surprise to the average Catholic. The Pope, bishops, and priests are all highly visible members of the ecclesiastical system. But what about that last level: The Domestic Church?

During the Second Vatican Council, the council fathers wrote The Dogmatic Constitution on the Church, otherwise known as Lumen Gentium. Their purpose in writing this document was not only to describe the organizational make-up of the Church, but to suss out the Mystery of the Church, shedding light on the theological and pastoral realities behind the visible structures. The Church is not only a hierarchy, but the Body of Christ in which all (the laity, religious, and the ordained) take part in the common priesthood of the faithful by participating in the one priesthood of Christ (Lumen Gentium 10). In other words, each one of us are meant to serve and sacrifice as Christ did, and since we are all called in this way, this is a lifelong process that begins in childhood. This is where the Domestic Church comes in.

Lumen Gentium teaches that the family is the Domestic Church. It is where parents are meant to be the first "preachers" of the word of God to their children, encouraging them and each other to participate in the life of the Church as part of the Body of Christ. The family is a microcosm of the Body of Christ; each member contributing according to their abilities and each supported according to their needs.


Typically at LCC, we require all of our students to participate in serving their home parishes and the wider community, hoping that they will understand that serving others is part of their calling as children of God. However, during the quarantine, this sort of service was not possible. Instead, we encouraged our students to turn back to the Domestic Church, the origin of their own journeys to serve as Christ did, and to serve their families. While many had family responsibilities prior to the stay at home orders, being required to consciously reflect on how their work impacted their families, especially during a highstress time, helped many of our students to realize just how essential their contributions are. Many noted that they never realized how valuable the big and little acts they perform for their families help to cultivate a more loving and peaceful relationship within the home and contribute to the foundational nature of the Domestic Church. This renewed sense of their own potential impact inspired quite a number to start planning more effective ways to carry this out into the world.

Sometimes, as lay people having been inured to the significance of our participation in the Church, it is helpful to remind ourselves that we are more than just a passive part of the Body of Christ. The Church is not just the hierarchical structure of the Pope, bishops, and priests, but we all take an active role as part of the common priesthood of the faithful.

faculty spotlight



Noel Cordle English Instructor

Noel has been at LCC for four years.

"Winning the Quatman Award at the end of the 2018-19 school year is one of my proudest accomplishments. More than any kind of award or accolade, though, simply keeping in touch with my students and hearing their successes always gives me immense pride. I always say that their "thank you's" and shared victories are much better than any paycheck or award I could ever receive!"

Transitioning to online learning was a challege for Noel. "I always thought I would enjoy it, but being essentially thrown into it with this emergency situation really was more difficult than I anticipated. I missed the daily, personal interaction with my students more than I ever thought possible. In order to try to maintain some level of that, I tried to frequently assign video responses through Flipgrid so that I could still see my students. I also started some weekly routines such as giving students a chance to share any special concerns or intentions with me so that I could pray for them and also asking them to "tell me something good" through a class comment so that we could all share ideas of what was keeping us sane or bringing us joy. Because one class I teach is a college-level composition course, I did find that the online format worked really well for editing and revising student work individually, so that is a success I will take away for future instruction."



Wes Horstman Math and Social Studies Instructor

Wes just completed his eighth year at LCC.

"One of the ways I incorporate faith into my classroom is talking about the Love of Family. I often talk about my children and the goofy or funny things they do, but I also talk about how my wife and I are trying to raise them as good Christians. We have our oldest two, William (4) and Teddy (3) lead us in prayer during meal time or the bedtime praver. Sulli (1) is just starting to get the "Ámen" and holding his hands together while praying."

Wes enjoys, "the growth and maturity of students from their freshman to their senior year is something that is very satisfying as a teacher."

The transition to online learning was easier for Wes. "Making videos and posting assignments on google classroom was something I have done before. One of the highlights is seeing students overcome the uncertainty during the corona-virus and some have excelled with the online, remote schooling."



Deb Huber Science Instructor

Previously Deb taught at LCC and Rhodes, this was Deb's fifth year as an official Thunderbird though.

Deb adds faith into her classes a variety of ways. One way, "I spotlight a connection between faith and science on Google Classroom and in class.

Deb is filled with pride, "when I see a student expressing their faith, asking questions about their faith, excelling in science, seeking a better understanding of science. or overcoming an obstacle to their success in my class, I feel a great sense of pride that I could contribute to the environment that enabled them to do so."

"My transition (to online learning) was relatively smooth since I previously used Classroom heavily to keep me and my students organized and clearly communicate with students. I immediately switched Classroom topics to dates. My biggest challenges included making and sharing videos that all students could access and want to watch and narrowing down the length of an assignment.'

"For this year, I am using an online textbook, ck-12, that has embedded videos, interactive applications, and adaptive guizzes. I am able to edit the units and adapt to student needs throughout the year. As for the length of my lessons, the more difficult the course the more challenging it was to shorten the assignment. The science lessons in ck-12 are designed for 15-20 minutes. This will make it much easier for me to adjust the length of my lessons this year."



Elizabeth Luersman Art Instructor

This will be Elizabeth's second year at LCC.

"I like to incorporate faith into my classroom through art. I teach my students that art is a wonderful way to express their feelings, ideas, beliefs, and thoughts. It is a peaceful way to share your beliefs with the world. Religion has played a large role in art history, especially through Catholicism. A goal of mine in my teaching is to show this history to my students and allow them to be inspired by it. They can then create beautiful works of art that express their personal beliefs and feelings.'

"The transition to online learning was difficult for everyone involved. My personal struggle was that I was not sure how to teach art online, especially since my students wouldn't have all of the different supplies that are available in school. I also was nervous that I wouldn't be there to physically show them how to improve their work. Thank goodness for videos, zoom, and photos!! I was able to record myself creating art so that my students could follow along with me. I had my students take pictures of their work, and I provided feedback as much as I could. The best highlights of this was getting feedback from students that creating art was their escape during these weird times. Art is a wonderful outlet and therapy for me, and it overjoyed me to be able to share that with my students. They created amazing work and I couldn't be prouder!!"

The theme for this past school year was "if it doesn't challenge you, it doesn't change you." Due to the events stemming from Covid 19 we all have been challenged and forever changed. In a matter of days our lives came to an abrupt halt. We left our school on March 13, uncertain about what the final guarter of the school year would look like.

"I think the school adjusted to the changes very well. Thank you for supporting my child."

While we couldn't be together in person, we tried to provide a level of normalcy. Every morning, staff or students led prayer, the pledge and announced birthdays virtually. We shared Stations of the Cross, the May Crowning, our Baccaleaureate Mass all online. Every major event that was scheduled on our calendar we were able to honor in some way.





These workers put their own life and possibly family members at risk everyday to protect those they serve. Below are some alumni that exemplify these sacrifices and show what it is to be a Thunderbird!



Raymond Decanio, 1998

I went into medicine because I wanted to help people and I loved the sciences. After I graduated from LCC I was able to volunteer at clinics translating for spanish-speaking patients, work as a phlebotomist, and work in organic chemistry and microbiology research labs. I had a wonderful experience at Xavier University, where I went to college, and they had a great Pre-Med program with helpful advisors. It felt a lot like

LCC in that it was a smaller private school setting that cared a a lot about their with helpful advisors. The more I immersed myself into medicine, the more I grew to love it.

The biggest challenge has been adjusting to all of the changes from our normal daily lives. It's changed the way we interact with our loved ones, the way we worship, the way we work, and the way we deliver and seek out medical care. I think we are all eager to return to some sense of normal, and that's going to take some time.

There has been some sacrifices and issues I have had, obviously conserving PPE was a concern, especially early on, but I think that situation has improved significantly thanks in large part to those efforts. However, small adjustments like that pale in comparison to the sacrifices that patients and their families have had to make during this pandemic.

I'm most impressed with seeing first hand how the people in the healthcare field have tackled this pandemic head on. Everyone has been exemplary. Really the same could be said for the community as a whole. We've all had to step up in various wavs.



Anna Heider, 2012

I am a registered nurse in the ICU. I went into nursing because I felt called to care for others. I always knew I wanted to work in the medical field and nursing was the perfect blend of possessing scientific knowledge and providing hands on, compassionate care.

As a nurse during this time, the way we work has totally changed. With the integration of COVID patients in our facility we have had to learn totally new ways of treating

patients and structuring our workflow so that we can care for them safely. As an ICU nurse, my colleagues and I have led the way in delivering hands on care and new treatments to COVID patients. We have also had a large role in training other nurses in the facility how to manage ICU patients safely. While COVID has changed how we work, it has given us opportunities to grow stronger as a team and as a community.

During the coronavirus outbreak my niece was born. Due to the nature of my job, including having to work with COVID patients daily, I was unable to meet her until she was 3 months old. The limited contact with family and friends until we knew more about COVID was really difficult.

During this time, the support and generosity of the community has been amazing. We have had so many people and businesses support us through donations, prayers, and thoughtful gestures. It has truly shown us that we're all in this together!

Mark Link, 1987



I was taught by my parents and from the Catholic community to always help and serve people. I have had the opportunity to help change the lives of many people in my service of 28 years with the Lima Police Department. For me. this has been very satisfying in knowing that I may have helped make a small difference for betterment when it was needed

The biggest challenge for me has been, having to wear a

mask out in public. I want people to remember my face and know who it was that helped them. Both in good times and when they needed my help most.

Something that has affected me is not being able to go out to restaurants, meet and/or visit family and friends. Just like everyone else.

I am grateful for all of the support I/we (in Law Enforcement) have received from people I know and don't know. On and off duty, I've had numerous people come up to me and thank me for my service. That is VERY satisfying!



Erica Schwaiger Kemp, 2003

I am a DO attending Pulmonary, Critical Care, and Sleep Medicine Physician in Tampa, FL. I always had an interest in healthcare, and science in general. My mother is a nurse, now a Nurse Practitioner, and I always really looked up to her, valued particularly her fierce patient advocacy and high standards.

One of the greatest challenges (of the pandemic) has been the difficulty in trying to treat a disease that is not like any

other disease process. We do not have a clearly defined treatment, and the treatments we have tried do not globally lead to improvement. Even in the last few months, we have made several major changes to how we approach treatment, with some improvement. It is frustrating to tell patients that of the therapies we are offering, none of them are proven helpful, and it is even possible that future investigation will find them harmful.

Another challenge is trying to explain away the rampant misinformation on social media. Unfortunately, increased access to information on the internet has not led to spread of accurate information.

Some challenges I have made personally is working longer hours which means less family time, I have a 7-month-old son, and some days I do not see him awake at all. There is a lot of fear from the healthcare community of bringing the virus into our homes and unintentionally infecting our loved ones.

Most of us now have completely new routines when going home. This outbreak has affected nearly every healthcare professional I've encountered mentally. The stress of watching people die from something we have limited information about, at often younger ages, is difficult. Families cannot always be with their loved-one in the hospital. In some cases we are allowed to let them in during final moments. However, if the family member has COVID as well, we have had to resort to video or telecommunications for end-of life discussions and during the final moments of life.

Professionally there has also been changes, our patient census (the number of patients we see per day) has nearly tripled from what we normally see, especially at this time of year, when the numbers are usually lower. These numbers are much higher than flu season numbers, and at times can be dangerous. As the numbers of patients increase, the numbers of doctors, nurses, respiratory therapists do not. At the hospitals I work at, accommodations have been made to increase needed capacity for ICU beds. The experimental medications to try to treat the virus are in short supply, so they cannot be offered to everyone. We are accustomed to working with abundant resources - this experience is certainly eye opening.

A positive thing is it has been nice to see communities try hard to support their small businesses by any means possible, come together to make masks and surgical caps for healthcare workers. We have seen large companies re-allocate their production to assist with making PPE and donating to hospitals. This has forced us to figure out alternative and helpful ways to seek healthcare (telemedicine), seek entertainment (virtual tours and classes on the internet), etc.

Deb Schrock Schwaiger, 1978



My Aunt Joyce was a nurse and throughout my childhood, always admired her for that. Nursing was and is still a well-respected position caring for people. I wanted to be a nurse that could assist the patient during their illness or injury until they achieved wellness. After 25-years of cardiac and emergency nursing, I completed the advanced practice nursing track as a Certified Nurse Practitioner (CNP) and then Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) serving as a family primary care provider. The family primary care provider works in the outpatient setting and essentially

works with patients to develop a plan of care to promote health and prevent disease throughout their lifespan.

Professionally, the biggest challenge for me was not having a solid foundation of knowledge about the COVID-19 virus. Initially, we knew very little about this virus, relying on the experiences of other countries of what worked and what did not. We may know more about COVID now, after several months being faced with it but we still do not know enough. It is a challenge to assist patients in coping with their fears and encouraging safety and prevention when there is so much conflicting information floating around in social media.

My personal challenges, which may sound selfish, consist of not being able to see my children and three grandsons as I was previously able.

The COVID outbreak has required me, and most healthcare providers, to adjust into a guick transition of telehealth also known as video care. Currently, we are seeing more patients in the clinic, but we are still using telehealth and expect it to continue.

Something positive I've seen is, I have a friend that made homemade face masks for all the staff in several healthcare practices, including my clinic, which was needed at a time of limited face mask availability. Local individuals and businesses were donating additional personal protective equipment, hand gel and soaps. Our organization had volunteers making masks for the patients. Organizational nurses volunteered to provide relief in COVID epicenters. Friends and families have learned to creatively practice safe contact.


