

**Washington County HS/JH – USD 108 - Event Notification**  
**(Updated 9/11/2020 – COVID-19 Guidelines Included – IN RED)**

USD 108 is a proud member of the TVL League. All TVL membership schools are fully united to do everything possible to provide our children, staff, parents, communities and respective counties with a full school year from beginning to end. We value learning, activities and opportunities that can best be provided in our school building. We ask that you follow our county health guidelines, USD 108 guidelines, and our united TVL guidelines regarding COVID-19. In return we will do everything possible to make sure the very same is extended to your district. **RED TAPE AND RED CONES INDICATE AREAS WHERE MASKS MUST BE ON AND WORN AT ALL TIMES. MASKS MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES INSIDE ANY USD 108 BUILDING.**

**Entrance Gates**

**Football – Visitors:** Visiting guests **will park in the South East Parking Lot Area and use the South Gate Entrance. These will be clearly marked.**

**Football – Home:** Washington County **will park in front of the JH/HS buildings and use the West Gate Entrance. Masks are to be worn and in place by everyone at this point.**

**Gates – Outside Field:** **There will be two gate lines. One line will be for those fans who have the exact amount and do not need to make change. The other gate keeper will have gloves on and will be able to make change.**

**Inside Buildings:** **Everyone will enter through the Main WCHS Entrance Doors, which are located on the East side of the building facing the Football field. You must have masks on to enter the front doors. You will be temp screened. We will follow the same protocol that is used at the football field.**

We have very good parking at WCHS/WCJHS. There are six identified handicap parking spots right in front of the High School. Wherever there are parking lines, there is a place to park. We ask that fans do not get “creative” when things start to fill up.

**Admission:**

**Red Zone Areas:** **When you enter any area that is RED ZONE, you are to have your face mask on and use the hand sanitizers repeatedly while in that area. These are all common-shared areas (Entrances, Concession Stands, Restrooms, Bleachers If Not Spaced at Least 3’ Apart)**

**Face Masks:** ***Outside Events: Strongly Recommended at all times. Each bleacher area and shared common ground areas have 6’ social distancing marking, identified by BLUE tape. Each respective administration is asked to monitor and supervise your fans choices and behaviors. FACE MASKS REQUIRED INSIDE RED ZONES***

**Inside Events: Mandatory Requirement.** You will not be permitted into any of the buildings with having a Face Mask on. It is to be kept on throughout you stay and use of our buildings.

If you need to step outside to take a break, just notify the gate worker and please step out and into the grass area away from the sidewalk and building. This area will be marked. If others might be in that “mask break area” please observe 6’ distancing. This outside “mask break area” is not a smoking areas. Thanks for understanding!

***KSHSAA has made it very clear who is to have face masks on during all inside competitive events. Your help in following their guidelines and our Washington County Health, USD 108, and TVL Guidelines is expected and greatly appreciated. We all want school to happen this entire year. Inconvenience is a small price to pay to do our part. Thank you!***

**Temperature Screening:** **Teams: A USD 108 employee will great you when you arrive. As you get off the bus, you are to have your masks on and you will have your temperature scanned. After you get your gear and equipment, you’ll be escorted to your locker rooms. Once you get in your locker room, you may take your masks off. The next time you will need to wear your mask is when you are exiting the building after the game.**

**What If’s:** USD 108 will always error on the side of caution. It is understood that high heat and sun can affect the scan. If a person shows as 100\* or higher, we will ask them to step aside and step into a cooler area for a moment. We will have seating available. If after an extend period of time a person is still showing a high temperature, we will ask your name and go over the COVID-19 questions. After that is completed, we will ask that person to leave or return to their vehicle until the game is over. We will also notify the administrator(s) of both schools. We will have medical staff members on site during Football games.

**Football Bleacher  
Seating - Visitors**

**6' Spacing – About 60 seats    3' Spacing – About 120 seats    Seat-to-Seat – About 400 seats**  
There is open grass area OFF of the Track that fans can use. Fans are certainly welcome to bring in lawn chairs and such. We will insect spray before home games, but it's always wise to bring some with you. To standing or seating chairs on the track will be permitted. Please use the grass areas. Visiting Team administration is asked to monitor this on your side and deal with it as you see fit.

**Gym Bleacher  
Seating – All**

All HS Quad Varsity Games will be held in the West Elementary Gym. Bleachers have been marked, showing 2' spacing. Each participating school will be assigned a zone to cheer from. Each school will remain in that zone, regardless of which net your team is competing on. You can see play well from any of the four zones. Masks must be on at all times in the building. Social distancing is expected, but it is understood that respective schools know who is family and who is not. We will leave it up to the discretion of each supervising administrator to campus your own zone.

We will use the HS Gym for JV and JHS matches. Those bleachers have been marked into 6' sections. There are two outside walkways to get from one gym to the next.

**Concession Stand-FB:**

We have divided our concession stand into two sides. One for visiting guests and one for home. We ask that visitors use the Concession Stand windows on the North East side. It will be marked. Home will use the South West side. **COVID -19 Guidelines are very clear on what we can and cannot provide this year. We have worked with our Washington County Health Department and we have been approved to serve pre-packaged meal type items. Of course there will be Water, Drinks, Chips, Candy, Cookies, etc... We will also be pre-packaging (and following guidelines) and have Hot Dogs and Hamburgers meals available. We are very fortunate to have an amazing USD 108-foot service program and Athletic Booster Club. You are certainly welcome to use the main concession stand. Just remember, common areas are RED ZONES and masks are required. No outside food or drink will be permitted into the facilities.**

**Concession Stand-VB:**

The concession stand will be in the corner of the West Elementary Lobby. No food will be taken in the gyms. Bottled drinks are acceptable, but please no food. Tables will be set up for you to use.

**Restrooms FB:**

**We will have 3 Purple Portables on the football field visitor's side. One of those will be handicap accessible. Our goal is not to keep you isolated from our side, but we truly do want to respect everyone's need to feel safe and secure. You are more than welcome to head west and use restrooms in the Tiger Building. Just remember that common area is a RED ZONE and masks are required.**

**Restrooms-VB:**

Everyone will need to use restrooms located on the HS side. All other hallways will be closed. Thank you for working with us.

**Locker Room(s):**

**These will be completely sprayed and sanitized prior to you arriving. We will make sure that all lockers are closed and secure and that everything has been removed from the room. There will be multiple hand sanitizers in your locker room. We are glad to provide those for your use and safety. We ask that coaches be the last one in the locker room and that you take with you any items that your athletes left behind. As soon as you are leave the locker room, our custodial staff will be in there spraying and sanitizing. Any items left behind will be thrown away.**

**CHANGES...Timely, respectful, and on-going communication is going to be paramount this entire school year. Keeping parents, workers, officials, media, students, concession stands, emergency volunteers informed so everyone is well informed and prepared is going to be huge! Washington County will do our very best to keep you informed should anything happen that might interfere with establishing playing times. The hosting school will make it a point to contact the visiting team at least 48-hours ahead of the playing date. Thank you for returning calls and making calls as soon as possible when there is a need! Here's hoping we can make it through without major interruptions. It's time to "PLAY BALL!" LET'S START AND FINISH THE WHOLE YEAR!**
