Dear Superior Central Online Academy Parents and Students,

This past spring and summer have presented us with some new and unexpected challenges. These challenges have led our district to create the Superior Central Online Academy (SCOA). I want to thank you for giving us the opportunity to continue to provide you with an education. While researching the different options to provide remote learning during this time we were introduced to Edgenuity. Edgenuity was founded in 1998 and served over 4,000,000 students last year. I have seen many online “platforms” in the past 20 years, and I believe that Edgenuity is one of the best.

Students utilizing the SCOA will begin classes on Tuesday, September 8, 2020.

SCOA students in grades Kindergarten through 5th grade will be using Edgenuity’s Accelerate Education Curriculum. These courses are taught by one of Edgenuity’s state certified teachers. A teacher from Superior Central will be checking in weekly with each student (parent) to make sure that everything is running smoothly.

SCOA students in grades 6th through 12th will be using Edgenuity’s Curriculum. These courses are taught by one of our teachers here at Superior Central. Like the elementary, a teacher from Superior Central will be checking in weekly with each student.

All students who are participating in the SCOA are asked to come to the Superior Central High School Office from 3:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Thursday, September 3rd. During this time a Chromebook will be distributed, if needed, and signature paperwork for online enrollment will be collected. It is important that a parent or guardian be present.
