As many of you know, the seniors were invited to a zoom session last week to discuss our contingency plans for some of the traditional events at the end of the year. I fielded several questions about the guidelines we have modified for their capstone presentations and talked about their feelings regarding Prom and Graduation.

The LCC Administration has now officially made the decision to postpone our Graduation from May 9 to Sunday afternoon, June 14, at 2:00. After consulting with several community and diocesan officials, and of course with our seniors, many felt that the May 9 date would simply be too soon for everyone to feel comfortable with such a large gathering, even if the stay-at-home order is lifted. If we are still unable to hold large events on June 14, we will organize a virtual commencement. By making this difficult decision now, we hope that families will have enough time to plan accordingly. One way or another, diplomas will be conferred on June 14!

We are still making decisions regarding the Baccalaureate Mass and Prom. Obviously, it is important for us to try our best to make these special events happen for our seniors. It is possible that both will be rescheduled to the same weekend as Graduation and as soon as I am able to provide more details, I will share that information with you. Thank you for understanding.
