To make the process of giving blood quicker, go to [redcrossblood.org/RapidPass](http://redcrossblood.org/RapidPass) the day of the blood drive and read the information there, answer the questions, and print your ticket! The more units collected means a Beta/FFA student will receive more scholarship money at the end of the year. This year the Red Cross will also be providing another service-- Antibody testing for Covid-19. What is the Antibody Test? An antibody test screens for antibodies in your blood, which are formed when fighting an infection, like COVID-19. An antibody test assesses whether your immune system has responded to the infection, not if the virus is currently present. The COVID-19 antibody test is authorized by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration (FDA).

Any students or employees interested in giving blood at the High School Beta Club American Red Cross blood drive on **Thursday, September 17**, can sign up at the main office with Mrs. King. She will have the appointment book and parental consent forms for 16 year old students who want to donate blood.
