Dear Parents of La Grange Elementary Students and Staff of La Grange Elementary School:

La Grange ISD has been notified that three students, a 1<sup>st</sup> grader, 3<sup>rd</sup> grader, and 4<sup>th</sup> grader in La Grange Elementary School have tested positive for COVID-19. The students have not been in school since Friday, September 11, 2020. Due to the positive cases, La Grange ISD is implementing the protocols outlined in the Safe Return School document.

Our campus has been following the health and hygiene guidelines announced by the Texas Education Agency (TEA), the Center for Disease Control (CDC), and the state health department. These practices include the wearing of masks for 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> graders, social distancing as much as feasible, providing hand sanitizer stations, no shared water, working in small groups, and eating lunch in classrooms.

Parents of students who have been identified as having had close contact with the students in each grade level through contact tracing will receive personal notifications.

Any student who experiences any of the symptoms of COVID-19 should self-isolate. As a reminder, the symptoms of COVID-19 are as follows:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Chills
- · Repeated shaking with chills
- Muscle pain--significant
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
- Diarrhea
- Congestion or runny nose
- Shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Nausea or vomiting
- Feeling feverish or a measured temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
