2020 EVENT GUIDELINES

Fans,

We ask for your help to ensure a safe environment for student-athletes, coaches, officials, and spectators. The guidelines below are in place for any event hosted on the Prairie Home School campus including **Youth**, **Junior High and High School events**.

PRAIRIE HOME'S PRIMARY GOALS:

- 1. The safety of our schools and community;
- 2. The ability of our students to continue to attend in-person school daily; and
- 3. Trying to ensure that our student-athletes & organization members have the opportunity to participate & complete their athletic & competition seasons with as few interruptions as possible. We believe these guidelines will help us achieve those goals.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- We ask that you **PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND** if you are sick or generally not feeling well.
- Concessions will still be available, but with pre-packaged goods, and staffed with people wearing masks.
- No gatherings will be permitted on the court or field or stage at the conclusion of any event.
- Live Stream: Prairie Home will *try* to broadcast home events via Facebook Live on the Prairie Home School Facebook page.

INDOOR EVENT PROTOCOL

- Face Coverings are HIGHLY recommended. As of now, they are not required. That is subject to change via direction from the Cooper County Health Dept. at a moment's notice.
- Social Distancing is HIGHLY recommended in seating areas and in concession lines.
- Home fans/students will be seated on the bleachers closest to the weight room. (Southwest bleachers)
- Visiting fans/students will be seated on bleachers closest to the hallway. (Northeast bleachers)

OUTDOOR EVENT PROTOCOL

- Face Coverings are HIGHLY recommended. As of now, they are not required. That is subject to change via direction from the Cooper County Health Dept. at a moment's notice.
- Social Distancing is HIGHLY recommended in seating areas and in concession lines.
- Home fans/students will be seated on the bleachers closest to the parking lot.
- Visiting fans/students will be seated on the bleachers on the batting cage side.

Prairie Home Activities Plan with Categories

Plan for Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular Conference Events

Category 1 - No County Restrictions

- Practices, games, and performances will go on as scheduled.
- Per MSHSAA guidelines, masks will be mandatory for all players, coaches, managers, staff, and event workers.
- Players can remove mask when performing strenuous physical activity
- No limits on attendance for spectators
 - For away games, there could be restrictions on attendance, please look for announcements for away game details.
- Masks will be highly encouraged for all spectators.
- Designated seating areas for home/visiting spectators.
- Hang signs around the stadium/gym encouraging social distancing
- Routine announcements from PA about social distancing in the stands and lines for bathrooms/concessions
- Extra sanitizing for areas of use, social distancing seating for those in attendance
- Concession stands will be open
 - NO outside food will be allowed until further notice
- Encourage parents to transport students home from away games
- Note: Students who are full on-line learning will be not eligible for extra-curricular activities.

Category 2 -- County Restrictions/Limitations on Attendance

- Practices, games, and performances will go on as scheduled.
- Per MSHSAA guidelines, masks will be mandatory for all players, coaches, managers, staff, and event workers.
- Players can remove mask when performing strenuous physical activity
- Limited guest will be allowed at contest, this will depend on numbers allowed by county restrictions.
- Mask will be required by guest.

Category 3 - County Shelter in Place Conditions

All practices and games will be postponed/cancelled
