

6th-8th Grade Remote Learning Information

September 17, 2020

- Remote Learners in Grades 6-8 will use Edgenuity Courseware starting Sept 21, 2020
- Your child will be assigned coursework in ELA, Math, Science and Social Studies through Edgenuity
- If you would like to see a list of additional electives available from Edgenuity (e.g. foreign language), please contact Mrs. Ballard d52kball@d52schools.com. These electives would be independent studies and a WMS teacher would not be monitoring this coursework
- The courses will be mapped out for the school year. Your child will work at their own pace, using the target end date of May 27, 2020.
- Your child's teachers will have access to reports in Edgenuity to be able to monitor progress and determine if students need additional support on a specific skill or in a specific area.
- Check-in's will be provided by teachers for your child each week. This support will occur between 1:40-3:15. Classroom teachers will communicate the days and specific times they will meet with your child on Zoom to check-in each week.
- If you have tech issues or problems with Edgenuity please contact support@d52schools.com. If you contact your child's classroom teacher, please allow 24 hours for a response. If it's something specific to Edgenuity, there is a live chat feature at the bottom of the homepage
- Parents will have access to the Parent Portal in Edgenuity where you can track your child's progress. Information will be forthcoming on how to set up your parent account.
- If your child is unable to login and complete the work in Edgenuity please call the school office to report an absence.
- Please email d52slink@d52schools.com if you will need lunches-these will be available each week to pick up on Tuesday from 9:00-10:00.
- Please note that if the school/district has to return to all students doing remote learning, your child will continue to use Edgenuity in a self-paced manner and will not transition back to what they have been doing since August.
- When your child returns to in-person learning, please know that teachers will continue to differentiate instruction. Some content may be reviewed or repeated, but meeting students' needs and differentiation will be provided to the highest extent possible.
- Your child will participate in one elective: Art, Library, Music, or Rtl. Students scheduled for Art, Library or Music will attend one Zoom meeting each week to check in, review content, and ask questions. The other four days, students will be expected to work approximately 20-30 minutes independently. Instructional materials will be available to students on Google Classroom.
- Physical Education - Students will receive a daily task that will mostly focus on Fitness. Students that are remote should look in google classroom on Monday for tasks to be completed by Friday.
- Rtl groups will be formed and offered virtually for students who need intervention starting in October. More information will be forthcoming.
