Send Notes: If your child is going to be riding on a <u>non-school sponsored float</u> (clubs or other), leaving school with a HS sibling, or will be getting picked up by a family member prior to the parade, please send a note with your child to drop off in the office so we can accurately account for everyone. There are a lot of moving pieces on Homecoming Friday and your notes will help us keep track of where everyone is or is supposed to be.

Bussing: After the Parade, JH students that ride the bus will walk with their teachers to Lennox Elementary School to board their bus home. There will not be any transfer busses picking up students at the High School on Friday, September 25. The Worthing bus will still pick up students at the High School. Students that do not ride the bus may walk back to the Junior High/High School so that parents that wish to pick up their students at the High School may do so (doing this may ease some of the traffic congestion that is expected at the Elementary School on Friday).
