# Virtual Enrichment Seminar Program



## Courses for students in grades 3-5

Students in grades 3-12 are provided the opportunity to participate in challenging and enriching seminars pursuing a wide variety of interests over the course of four to six Saturday mornings. Seminars are offered each fall and are held on the SUNY Oneonta campus. (The S.A.T. preparation course is also offered in the spring.) The program was first established in 1958 and has been continuously running since. Many of our programs are taught by pre-service teacher candidates.

### Information for Students & Parents / Guardians

**DATES:** Seminar classes take place on FOUR consecutive Saturdays – Oct. 3,10, 17 and 24th.

**TIMES:** 1.5-2 Hours of Instruction via ZOOM beginning at 9:30am. Instruction will include both whole group, small group and individual learning sessions depending on the class. Exact structure will be determined by each instructor and communicated prior to the first class.

**COST:** \$65.00 per 4-week participant (paid to student's school district)

**REGISTRATION:** Please contact your guidance office directly for further details on how to register your student. The attached forms must be submitted by you to your district. All registrations will be forwarded by your school district to the Study Council; we cannot accept them directly from parents. All registrations are considered final as of the end of the registration period. Hiring of instructors is based on registrations. All students are enrolled with the full knowledge and approval of their respective school districts.

#### **REGISTRATION DEADLINE: September 23, 2020**

**ENROLLMENT:** Enrollment is based on a first-come-first-served basis. Completed (Individual) Student Information Sheets and Standard Release Forms must accompany the registration submitted by the school; students will not be registered without these forms. No registrations are accepted directly from parents, and the local school board policy applies.
