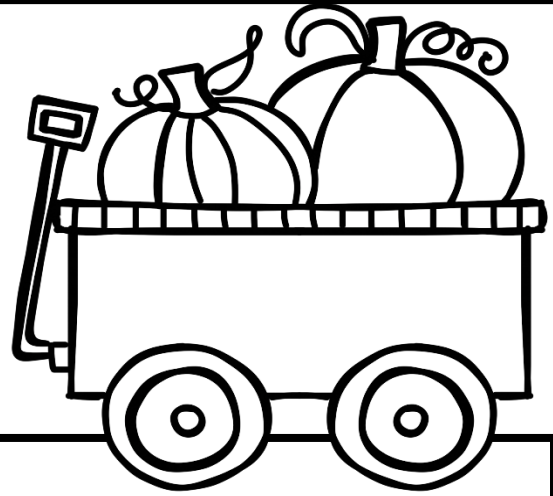

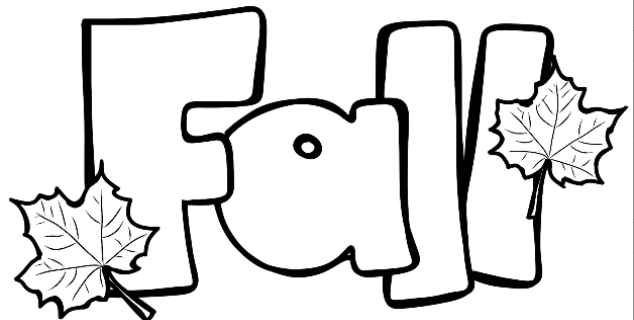
Problem Solving
