ATHLETIC COMPLEX

Masks Will Be Required For Entry. Temperatures And Screening Will Be Taken For Each Attendee. Teams Will Be Notified To Collect Temperatures And Answers To Screening Questions For Each Participant Prior To The Contest. Fans Will Be Subject To A Temperature Screening And Questionnaire Prior To Purchasing A Ticket. A Separate Area Will Be Used For The Purchase Of Tickets. Sidewalk Area Will Be Marked For Social Distancing.

Concessions Will Be Limited To Pre-packaged Items. There Will Be No Hot Dogs, Hamburgers, Popcorn Or Nachos That Must Be Made On Site. Area Will Be Marked For Social Distancing.

Locker Rooms Will Be Monitored By The Coaching Staff. No More Than 10 Participants Will Be Allowed To Enter At One Time To Change Into The Khsaa Required Uniform.

A Tent For Training Opportunities Will Be Moved Outside The Field House. Only One Participant Will Be Allowed To Be Seen By The Athletic Trainer In The Tent Area.

Seating Capacity Is 3364. Harrison County Home Contests In September Will Begin With A 20% Segment (672). Opposing Football Teams (Middle School And High School) Will Be Notified As The Number Of Tickets They Will Be Alotted. After Research From Past Years, We Have Not Eclipsed The 672 Tickets Sold For Any Soccer Game, So We Will Have General Admission Available For Soccer. For Home Contests In October, We Will Increase The Attendance Percentage To 30% (1,009), If Harrison County Covid Numbers Are At A Level In Which The Local Health Department Allows For The Safety Of Those In Attendance And For Those Participating.

Sidelines Will Be Limited To 24 (Khsaa Postseason Guidelines) Participants. Social Distancing Measures Will Take Place For Those On The Sideline. Masks Will Be Worn By Students Not Currently Participating In The Contest. There Will Be A Designated Isolation Tent In The Case That A Participant Does Not Feel Well. Cheerleaders And Band Will Not Be Permitted In September. If Covid Numbers Are In An Area Where We Can Increase Attendance In The Month Of October, With The Local Health Department's Guidance, We Will Have Cheerleaders And Band In October.

Officials Will Park And Enter The Field Area Across From The Bleachers.

There Will Not Be A Water Area. Players Will Be Instructed To Bring Their Own Water Bottles.

Only Essential Personnel Will Be Allowed In The Pressbox: Scorekeeper, Announcer, Two Media Persons From Each Team. Videographers (Football) And Coaching Staffs (Football) Will Be On Top Of The Pressbox. If Scorekeeper And Announcer Are Only Two For A Soccer Contest, Videographers Will Be Permitted. No Buffet Style Food Will Be Allowed In The Pressbox.

Seating Capacity Is 2002. Harrison County Home Contests In September Will Begin With A 20% Segment (400). After Research From Past Years, We Have Not Eclipsed The 400 Tickets Sold For Any Volleyball Game, So General Admission Will Be Available For Home Volleyball Contests. We Will Open Both Sides Of The Gymnasium Seating As To Determine A Home Side And A Visitor Side. In October, We Will Increase The Attendance Percentage To 30% (600), If Harrison County Covid Numbers Are At A Level In Which The Local Health Department Allows For The Safety For Those In Attendance And For Those Participating.

Sidelines Will Be Limited To 15 (Khsaa Postseason Guidelines) Participants. Social Distancing Measures Will Take Place For Those On The Sideline. Masks Will Be Worn By Students Not Currently Participating In The Contest. There Will Be A Designated Isolation Area In The Case That A Participant Does Not Feel Well. Players Will Not Switch Benches After Each Game. Cheerleaders And Band Will Not Be Permitted In September. If Covid Numbers Are In An Area Where We Can Increase Attendance In The Month Of October, With The Local Health Department's Guidance, We Will Have Cheerleaders And Band In October.

Officials Will Park And Enter The Gym Near The Cafeteria.

There Will Not Be A Water Area. Players Will Be Instructed To Bring Their Own Water Bottles.

Only Essential Personnel Will Be Allowed At The Scorer's Table: Scorekeeper, Announcer, Libero Tracker.
