15.I CAS Land Transfer

WHEREAS, the Madison Board of Education ("Board") entered into a Contract of Sale, dated May 28, 2014 ("Contract of Sale"), with the Borough of Madison ("Borough") for the transfer of property formerly known as the Green Village Road

School site; and

WHEREAS, Article 8.09 of the Contract of Sale provided that the Board is to transfer to the Borough a parcel of land situated at the southwest corner of the Central Avenue School property, abutting Block 1601, Lot 23, that is equal to one half acre; and

WHEREAS, upon a petition filed by the Borough, on February 18, 2020, the Planning Board for the Borough of Madison approved a minor subdivision of the Central Avenue School campus to create Block 1601, Lot 1.01 (the "Property"), which comprises of the one-half acre of land that will be transferred to the Borough in accordance with the Contract of Sale; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has committed in a letter from Mayor Bob Conley to Board President Heather Reddy on August 20, 2020, to design the landscaping and fencing in such a way as to minimize any "bottlenecking" associated with the Southeast corner of said property, and as necessary, for the Board of Education's satisfaction, this would include "cutting the corner" with the fencing and landscaping to allow for a more open feel between the areas; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2020, the Borough of Madison Council formally approved Resolution 234-2020, memorializing the Borough's intent to design the landscaping and fencing in such a way to address the issues presented in Mayor Conley's August 20, 2020 letter;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Property shall be transferred to the Borough in accordance with the Contract of Sale.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said transfer of Property is in consideration for the Borough agreeing to provide fencing and landscaping along the Property as memorialized in Resolution 234-2020, adopted by the Borough on September 14, 2020. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board President and the Business Administrator shall be authorized to execute the deed of conveyance, affidavit of title and any other documents necessary effectuate the transfer of this Property in accordance with the Contract of Sale.
