



Perhaps this will clear things up a bit.

When you add a printer to your Macbook there is this option down at the lower right.




Default printer: Last Printer Used
Default paper size: US Letter

You can change this option to a Printer that you want as your default printer – like below.




Default printer: HS LIBRARY (Ricoh 2851)

So when you print you will get a Print Dialog window like below that shows your “default printer”



The printer that is displayed is the printer CHOICE you made for “Default printer:”

So if you print to the SAME printer all the time you will use the same PRESET all the time and there is nothing to change.

BUT – if you change the printer you still have to select “your preset”

“Yea but” I selected ALL printers when I set up my preset.



Preset Name: TPedraza
Preset Available For: Only this printer, All printers
Cancel OK

Hopefully you did select all printers. That is telling “any other printer” that you want to use the same settings for ALL printers you print to.

*** You can set up all kinds of presets for each printer you use.
For example: I can set up 3 different presets for the same printer.
Each preset will use a *different* function or feature.

TPedraza – Print one sided documents, Print in black and white
TPedraza1 – Print duplex, Print in black and white
TPedraza2 – Print duplex, Print in color

“OR” you can select any of the above presets to use on another printer
