## Reading & Writing Checkpoints

IN ADDITION TO THE STATE STANDARDS ATTACHED, YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABLE TO :

- Build upon phonics skills learned in K-1 to decode more complex words (know all short and long vowel sounds as well as silent e rule)
- Read grade level text with accuracy, expression and understanding of meaning
- Use context clues to interpret meaning.
- Formulate a response with at least two examples of text evidence
- Organize and write a paragraph containing between five and eight sentences that relates to a specific topic using standard conventions

## Mathematics Checkpoints

IN ADDITION TO THE STATE STANDARDS ATTACHED, YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABLE TO

- Memorize Addition and Subtraction facts through 10
- Writing number words zero- one hundred
- Write expanded form up to one hundred
- Solve horizontal equations by correctly setting up problems vertically up to the hundreds place
- Recognize and draw shapes having specified attributes
- Partition squares, rectangles and circles into two and four equal parts
- Describe the parts using the words halves, fourths, a half of, and a fourth of
- Understand values of numbers in hundreds, tens, and ones places

## Patriot Foundations Checkpoints

IN ADDITION TO THE STATE STANDARDS ATTACHED, YOUR CHILD WILL BE ABLE TO :

- Have a conversation about a given topic that includes elaboration and justification on their viewpoints. This communication can be verbal or written.
- Create and explain a solution to a simple problem and record the results
- Work with a group to complete a multi-step task with assigned roles and responsibilities
- Create solution(s) to a question or problem, make connections between ideas and concepts that have been learned, and productively use time allotted to complete assignments
- Take responsibility for their actions, exhibit respect and attentiveness in class, and manage their own feelings as to not affect others
- Understand that mistakes are a part of the learning process, where to go to find resources/help to find the solution/answer, and manage their frustration
