



Kimberly Family 4-H Scholarship Guidelines

The Kimberly Family 4-H Scholarship has been established in memory of Michael L. Kimberly with the Nebraska 4-H Foundation. The scholarship has been established to promote the lifelong skills, leadership, and agricultural literacy that youth gain from the 4-H program and to support their continuing education. Mike and Kay Kimberly of Big Springs, NE were both 4-H members and continue to be lifelong supporters of the Keith County 4-H program along with their four daughters. 4-H has been a family tradition that continues with their grandchildren and has been one of their family highlights.

The Keith County 4-H program will promote the Kimberly Family 4-H Scholarship and a selection committee consisting of two 4-H Council members, two County Extension Board members and the Extension Educator may select up to two eligible high school seniors who have been enrolled in the Keith County 4-H program and plan to continue their education. Each scholarship will be worth \$500. If two scholarships are not awarded each year the money will remain in the Nebraska 4-H Foundation for the following year. It will be at the selection committees discretion if one or two scholarships will be awarded annually based on the qualifications of the applicants.

The Nebraska 4-H Foundation is responsible for managing the scholarship fund and the recipients must provide a copy of their first semesters unofficial college transcripts to the Nebraska 4-H Foundation before scholarship money will be issued for the second semester. Kimberly Family 4-H Scholarship requirements:

- 1.) Applicant must have been a member of the Keith County 4-H program for a minimum of 2 years.
- 2.) Applicant must be a high school senior and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- 3.) Applicant can utilize the scholarship at any 2-year or 4-year college program.
- 4.) Up to two applicants may be selected each year by the Keith County 4-H Council.
- 5.) Completed application is due by March 4th to the Keith County Extension Office. A completed 4-H Career Portfolio is NOT required, but may also be submitted with the application as additional information.

Scholarship applications are available at the Keith County Extension office or online at kap.unl.edu/4H. Applications are also available from the guidance counselors at Ogallala Public, Paxton, and South Platte High Schools. Recipients will be notified during the high school honors events.
