

VISTA: County Covid 19/Opioid Education

- ↻ Income - Estimated Monthly “living allowance” \$1,117.00/month
- ↻ Additional funding - Educational award (\$6,195.00) **OR** cash stipend (\$1,800.00) is also awarded after 1 full year of service.
- ↻ Travel reimbursement – none; however travel expenses can be calculated to equal work hours served.
- ↻ Service area/travel – The program will reach out and include schools, tribal government, civic organizations, community coalitions, health agencies, etc.
- ↻ Length of grant term - 1-year grant with re-funding a possibility.
- ↻ Length of service - The same person can serve in the role of VISTA: County Opioid Education for all three years if re-enrollment is approved *each* year.
- ↻ VISTA Training - VISTA training is all online.
- ↻ Reporting and data tracking - Data tracking requirements will include documentation of training from sign-in sheets and attendee feedback. An outreach log will also be kept by the VISTA: County Opioid Education.
- ↻ Cost share – the VISTA: County Opioid Education living allowance of \$1,117.00/month will incur a 20% cost share for the sponsoring school or agency (\$223.00 approx) plus \$50.00 per month to Forest Grove School to cover administration.
