



# DAW ELEMENTARY

## RESET/RESTART PLAN SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

1. **All students grades 4-7 will enter the main door and must have a face covering.** Students can begin entering the building at 8:00am. At 8:20am students will begin heading to their homeroom. The tardy bell rings at 8:30am.
2. **Students eating breakfast will head to the cafeteria** upon arrival. **Those not eating will be directed to the library** until we dismiss them for homeroom.
3. **Face coverings will be required at the bus stop and on the bus both before and after school.**
4. **There will no longer be a bus stop at Garfield Elementary in the morning or the afternoon to help ensure student safety. There will be a new stop created at the corner of Aten and Commerce.**
5. Each grade level team will develop a restroom schedule that limits the amount of students in the restroom at one time. Handwashing visuals and floor directional visuals will be in place to serve as reminders to help students, especially with social distancing.
6. There will be no drinking from the fountains. Hands free water bottle fillers have been installed on each floor. **Students will need to bring their own water bottle. Please make sure his/her name is on the bottle.**
5. Students will be eating lunch in multiple locations to ensure social distancing. Meals will be delivered to the rooms. Lunch will be the traditional 30 minutes.
6. Dismissal will be as follows: **Bus riders will be dismissed at roughly 2:40pm through the main doors. Walkers and pick ups will be dismissed following the exit of the busses. Both 5th and 6th grades will be dismissed through the doors located on the First Christian Church side of the building, grades 4th and 7th will be dismissed from the doors on the gym side of the building. It is extremely important to leave Center Street empty before the busses arrive.**

7. Cleaning supplies will be throughout the building, with maintenance staff sanitizing areas throughout the building the entire day. Heavy duty cleaning will be done daily after dismissal.
8. Students will be following their traditional schedules throughout the day.
9. Teachers will be integrating technology daily, so as to help prepare students in case we must move to remote learning. Additionally, all students will have access to Progress Book so that parents/guardians will be able to access students progress and grades.
10. **All students must wear a face covering. Students will be provided with a lanyard to help hold their masks.** Plastic dividers may be placed on desks and tables as an added measure of safety.
11. There will be **NO** Open House. **However, school supplies will be provided to all students the first week of school. This includes a clear bookbag.**
12. 4th grade orientation will be held on Monday, August 24th. Students whose last name starts with letters A-K will be reporting to the Daw cafeteria at 5:00pm with open house ending at 5:45pm. Students whose last name starts with letters L-Z will report to the cafeteria at 6:00pm. Masks will be required by all in attendance. This will be for fourth grade students and their parents/guardians only. We will also practice social distancing.
